Applicants must meet eligibility requirements including time-in-grade, time-after-competitive appointment, minimum qualifications, and any other regulatory requirements by the closing date of the announcement. Creditable specialized experience includes:

- Analyzing demand and supply chain data.
- Overseeing process interrelationships, process performance critical data, performance metrics that pertain to the demand/supply chain processes and recommend process improvements.
- Performing detailed analysis utilizing data from automated demand/supply systems (i.e. Distribution Standardization System (DSS), Enterprise Business Systems (EBS), Virtual Item Manager (VIM), Business Warehouse/Business Intelligence (BW/BI), Fusion Center).

- Recommending changes in how the demand/supply chain process is executed, including system changes or other process improvements.
- Providing guidance regarding automated system functionality and business capabilities.
